

Our goal is to keep all of our patients, families and staff healthy throughout this pandemic.

In order to stop the spread of COVID-19 we have been asked to decrease in person interactions.

We have limited our in person well visits to infants and children through 4 years of age to vaccine related well visits only. Infants and children ages 15 months and younger will be scheduled in the morning. Children ages 2 years and 4 years will be scheduled in the afternoon to minimize interactions and limit points of contact.

When you come for these visits, we ask that only one parent or caregiver accompany the child so as to limit points of contact. To adhere to the governor's requirement face masks or face coverings are to be worn. Face masks are not recommended for children ages 2 years and under, please cover infants and children's carriers and strollers with blankets when entering the building. We ask that you check in from your car, by calling the front office to review insurance information and provide copay. Please have your insurance card and payment information ready and available with you in the car. We will then instruct you how to come to our side door to be ushered by staff into an exam room.

In an effort to stay connected with families and remain attentive to your children's health and well-being in this challenging time, we have implemented Telemedicine visits. It is obviously not ideal but under the circumstances we think it gives us a chance to connect and check in about health and well-being of your child. We offer Telemedicine visits for all non-vaccine related well visits as well as sick visits, consults, follow ups and more.

We are offering Zoom and Facetime for all Telemedicine visits, please call our office and our front desk will be happy to set up a Telemedicine visit with you.

For Telemedicine Well Visits we are asking, if possible, to have the following information available for us:

- A list of current medications.
- Any new medical conditions.
- A list of any questions you may have.
- Height
- Weight
